Five Day Workshop: April 16-20 2012

with Maggie Carey

This 5 day intensive workshop is planned to provide opportunities for participants to extend on ideas and practices of narrative therapy they have gained through previous training. The features of this intensive include prioritizing the particular interests of participants which will actively shape the agenda of the intensive. There will be ongoing exploration of the skills of narrative therapy including

- Engaging with the metaphor of landscape to support story development and as a review of the maps of narrative practice.
- Employing the metaphor of 'scaffolding' in our enquiry.
- Exploring the 'absent but implicit' and scaffolding this as an action.
- Using narrative practice to respond to experiences of trauma and of grief and loss.
- Exploring practices of discourse deconstruction and responding to a sense of personal failure.

The focus of the intensive will be on the development of skills applicable in work with individuals, families, groups and communities. The teaching methodology will include live interviews, review of therapeutic conversations, sharing stories of work, gaining experience through structured exercises, descriptions of specific maps of narrative practice and group discussion. We hope to create a rigorous and lively learning experience where participants can further develop their ideas and skills in collaboration with others.

THE TEACHERS:

Narrative Practices Adelaide is located at 24 Hurtle Square, Adelaide. The teaching faculty includes **Maggie Carey, Shona Russell and Rob Hall**. Each of us are currently working as therapists and teachers and collectively have extensive experience in working with children, individuals, couples, families and communities, particularly in the area of responding to the effects of violence and abuse.
