A Series of 6 One-Day Workshops:

Commencing 11 March 2009, then monthly till September (except July)

For the first time we are offering a series of six, one-day narrative practice workshops each with a specific topic. We hope this series will provide ample opportunity for participants to thoroughly explore various practices of narrative therapy in their work with individuals, families and communities.

This series is to provide skills training for therapists, counsellors, psychologists, social workers and health professionals in the micro maps of narrative therapy as described by Michael White in “Maps of Narrative Practice”. Each one day workshop endeavours to build on participants’ interest by providing a detailed description of specific micro maps and opportunities to gain skills through structured exercises and discussion. Examples of work in a variety of settings will be shared. The topics covered will be:

11 Mar: Exploring key ideas underpinning narrative therapy and the narrative metaphor

15 Apr: The role of externalizing conversations

13 May: Re- Authoring lives through rich story development

10 Jun: Re- membering practices

(No workshop in July)

12 Aug: Creating an audience for preferred stories – Definitional ceremony and Outsider Witness practices.

09 Sep: The absent but implicit as a gateway to rich story development
